

Wakanda News Cards

Wakanda News pulls stories from 164 news sources from Black online publications across the Diaspora, and publications that have a large percentage of content relevant to Black communities.

While most of our sources are in the USA (today), our reach is global, and we currently pull content from publications in the Caribbean, the UK, and a dozen African nations.

Any publication with a public RSS feed can be included in Wakanda News.

Headlines and introductions of News stories are shown as what we call 'News Cards.'

When a user clicks on a 'News Card' shown previously, they are taken to a News Details Page which shows the story title, photo and the introductory article text.

Clicking on any of these takes the user to the source publication's web page.

To the right of the main story, the News Details page also promotes other stories from the same source publication. Clicking on any of those stories takes the user to a News Details Page for that story.

Below the main story, other News Cards from anywhere in our system that are related to the main story are shown. Our AI algorithms consider another Story 'related' when it makes references to people, places, events or ideas which are in the main story.




