Jean has questions about Covid vaccines, and has gotten conflicting information from his family and friends.



He has read several articles about disparate treatment of people in the US medical system based on their ethnicity, so he is a little leery to ask the doctors at his community health center.

Derek goes to the Ask A Doctor app on his phone, and tells the app that he would like to talk with a female doctor who speaks Haitian Creole, like his late mother.

The Ask A Black Doctor app searches its database and returns the closest match based on Derek's search criteria and the doctor's availability.

Dr. Suzette DeRoches is between appointments, and is able to speak with Jean right now, so they are connected by Ask A Black Doctor.



5

Before the appointment, Jean pays Ask A Black Doctor a \$20* Appointment Fee.

If Jean has Health Insurance, the balance of Dr. DeRoches' fee is paid by his Insurance.

If Jean does not have Health Insurance, the balance of the fee is paid by the BlackFacts Education Foundation Health Fund, which raises money from the Tech sector to fund Accurate Medical Information via Technology.
